


PEAR TREE SCHOOL

Free School Meals and Cost of Living Challenges

We are very aware that challenges continue to arise, and we work hard to make school events for the coming term as low cost as possible - we are however aware that there are 3 residentials planned. If you are struggling, please come and talk to us; do not worry in silence. We will do our best to help our community and may be able to help in some practical ways or signpost where you might be able to access additional support. All conversations will be treated in confidence. Payment plans are always available so please speak to Mrs Nixon in the office, Mr Greasby or your child's class teacher.

Remember you may qualify for Free School Meals. This brings in additional funding to school which helps towards trips and uniform, as well as school meals. It also allows you to access some free childcare in some of the holidays and other vouchers for food and heating. To check if you might be eligible click here: https://www.cheshireeast.gov.uk/schools/school-meals/free school meals.aspx

If your child is in receipt of income related free school meals, they are automatically eligible for the <u>Household Support Fund</u>.

You can claim free school meals for each child who attends school in Cheshire East if you receive one of these benefits:

- Universal Credit with no earned income or with net monthly earnings less than £616.67
- Income Support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income related Employment Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) and do not get Working Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

We suggest you do make a claim for free school meals even if your child is in key stage 1 as the school can claim additional funding (pupil premium) for new equipment and resources.

Thank you once again for your continued support of the school and we look forward to sharing the spring term with you.
